

The project «YEP-Young Europeans Promoting social enterprises» was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens"

Applicable to the Strand 2 – Measure 2.1 "Town-Twinning"

Participation: The project involved 339 citizens, notably 34 participants from the city of Wieliszew (Poland), 34 participants from the city of Dionysos (Greece), 34 participants from the city of Lanškroun (Czech Republic), 34 participants from the city of Herrera del Duque (Spain), 43 participants from the city of Serock (Poland), 60 participants from the city of Celleno (Italy), 50 participants from the city of Castiglione in Teverina (Italy) and 50 participants from the city of Graffignano (Italy). Moreover, the city of Dali (Cyprus), the city of Ceresara (Italy) and the city of Siret (Romania) participated to the YEP Multilateral Meeting in Italy with a total of 20 participants.

Location/ Dates: The event took place in **Celleno**, **Castiglione in Teverina and Graffignano**, **Italy**, from 14/09/2015 to 25/09/2015.

Short description:

The day of 14/09/2015 was dedicated to the arrival and accommodation of the delegations and to welcome activities. The day of 15/09/2015 was dedicated to cultural activities and to the seminar and debate on: The future of Europe; The Europe 2020 strategy for a smart, sustainable and inclusive growth; Entrepreneurship 2020: EU guidelines for the growth of new generations of entrepreneurs.

The day of 16/09/2015 was dedicated to cultural activities, to the round table: Social entreprises in the European labour market; SEs and social innovation: strategies and goals: what's social entrepreneurship?; SEs and future scenarios; Useful examples of SEs and, mostly important, to the signature of the Friendship and Cooperation Agreement among all the official YEP Partners and the two guest cities.

The day of 17/09/2015 was dedicated to cultural activities, to the workshop: Social entrepreneurship can make the difference; Youth entrepreneurship strategies; Best practices exchange, and to the seminar: Presentation of the Partners works done during the Local Meetings.

The day of 18/09/2015 was dedicated to cultural activities and to the debates: Can a sustainable and inclusive economy change people's lives?; We Need More Young Social Entrepreneurs; Innovative instruments to build a sustainable future; Widen the giving economy; Strengthen SEs; The SEs status; Social responsible businesses.

The day of 19/09/2015 was dedicated to cultural activities and to seminars on: FOCUS 1. New pathways to explore in social enterprises; SEs as sounding boards for the production and exchange of social services and local development; Partners experiences: Women and SEs; FOCUS 2. SEs and local development; Gender mainstreaming and local economic planning; Access to EU funds; The 2020 EU's growth and jobs strategy.

The day of 20/09/2015 was dedicated to cultural activities, to the debates: Work and family: how to help employed women; Initiatives to develop new pathways, and to the meeting with local Social Enterprises.

The day of 21/09/2015 was dedicated to cultural activities and to the debates: Successful strategies: we can make the difference; Tools for a concrete change; Examples of cultural metamorphosis among employers.

The day of 22/09/2015 was dedicated to cultural activities, to Partners meetings and exchange of Best practices from the Local Meetings, to future proposals and strategies and to the visit to some local Social Enterprises managed by volunteers.

The day of 23/09/2015 was dedicated to cultural activities and to the debate: The importance of Twinnings and Cooperation Agreements.

The day of 24/09/2015 was dedicated to cultural activities and to the debate: Planning of future cooperation activities.
